- May: PSC adoption of verification framework
- June: public communication of Partnership's BMP Verification Program
- Summer/Fall/Winter: BMP Verification Review Panel reviews of the jurisdictions' proposed BMP verification programs

Challenges

- Ensuring commitment to verification by <u>all</u> partners
- Seeing verification as an integral component of program implementation, not an undesired burden
- Addressing concerns about resources required to verify practices have been implemented
- Actively communicating with and engaging the thousands of local partners and producers
