




- Chesapeake Bay Comprehensive Plan = USACE Chesapeake Bay Master Plan
 - ▶ What can USACE do?
 - ▶ Where can USACE help YOU?
- Entire Bay + GIS integration + State/DC alignment = streamlined attack on future investments
 - ► Focus on 2014 Chesapeake Bay Agreement Goals and Outcomes
 - Informed by the Management Strategies and Action Plans
 - Assessment of critical needs and gaps by location
 - Evaluation on subwatershed level to identify priority areas
 - ► Focus future investments where USACE has authority and mission




Outcomes

- Defined role for USACE, integrated with work by others
 - ► Chesapeake Bay Design-Build Program (Section 510 Program)
 - ► Technical Services (no design/construction)
 - Support to other Federal agencies and DoD
 - Small Studies Program (<\$10M)
 - ▶ \$3M, 3-year Feasibility Studies
 - Ecosystem Restoration
 - Flood Risk Management
 - Navigation
 - Water Supply
- Optimize USACE funding existing and new – in support of Partnership goals
- Unify actions and investments by ALL






USACE Chesapeake Bay Master Plan



Timeline


- FY14 1 of 9 USACE new start studies in United States
- FY14/15 \$100K
- FY16 President's Budget = \$250K
- Complete 2 years after agreement executed (~2017)
- <\$3M
 - ▶ 75% Federal/25% non-Federal
 - ► \$2.25M Federal, \$0.75M non-Federal
- Sponsor = National Fish and Wildlife Foundation with inkind service support from States and DC

Path Forward

- May 2015 Finalize scoping and cost allocations with NFWF, CBP-EPA and states
 - ► PSC Approval (12 March)
 - State/DC Scoping Meeting (5 May)
- June 2015 Final reviews
- July 2015 (T) Execution
 of cost-sharing agreement with NFWF



Summary

- Opportunity to strategically <u>align USACE implementation</u> with priorities of Chesapeake Bay partners
- Integrated with ongoing efforts and initiatives NOT duplicative
- Guide future USACE investments
