







Governance & Management Framework

## 2024 Chesapeake Executive Council Charge

- Prepare revisions to the Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement
  - Edits to the vision, principles and preamble as necessary
  - Focus on updating the goals and outcomes
  - Public feedback (July & August)
  - Recommendations presented to Executive Council by end of 2025
- Recommend simplified and streamlined partnership structure by end of 2025
  - Incorporate into the governance ~June 2026

















## How might outcomes look?

#### Trees & Forests – for demonstration purposes only

Now	Proposed
Continually increase the capacity of trees and forests to provide air quality, water quality and habitat benefits throughout the watershed. Restore 900 miles per year of riparian forest buffer and conserve existing buffers until at least 70 percent of riparian areas throughout the watershed are forested. Expand urban tree canopy by 2,400 acres.	<ul> <li>Continually increase the capacity of trees and forests to provide air quality, water quality and habitat benefits throughout the watershed.</li> <li>Restore 900 miles per year of riparian forest buffer.</li> <li>Conserve and restore buffers until at least 70 percent of riparian areas throughout the watershed are forested.</li> <li>Expand community tree canopy by 2,400 acres.</li> </ul>
