

# Comparison of old and new MRIP estimates of recretional removals\* of Atlantic striped bass




——New Wikip Estimates

<sup>\*</sup>Recreational removals include landed fish as well as the 9% of fish released alive that die.





## **Total Removals by Sector**






#### **Recreational Catch and Release**

#### Addendum VI Overview



- Initiated Addendum VI in May 2019
- Public Draft Approved in August 2019
- Public Comment Late Summer
- Final Approval Last Week
- Implementation Plans Due November 30
- Technical Committee Review Dec/Jan
- Board Approval in February 2020
- Implementation April 1, 2020
- Circle Hook Required January 1, 2021



#### **Addendum VI Provisions**



- Commercial Quotas Reduced 18%
- Ocean Recreational 1 Fish @ 28-35"
- Chesapeake Recreational 1 Fish @ 18" min
- Mandatory Circle Hooks
- Conservation Equivalency Permitted
