

Virginia General Assembly sets the annual Bay reduction cap in compliance with ASMFC mandates

Virginia Marine Resources Commission moves to create a bait fishery with harvest allocation

Ecological reference points adopted by ASMFC; new quotas established; reduc tion of the Bay cap General Assembly did not adopt new ASMFC quota; ASMFC delays finding Virginia out of compliance General Assembly did not adopt new ASMFC quota; quota is exceeded by Virginia reduction fishery; ASMFC finds Virginia out of compliance

General Assembly passes legislation to transfer management to the Virginia Marine Resources Commission General Assembly passes legislation directing Virginia Institute of Marine Science to develop plans to study menhaden population in the Bay
